Agni-5: What is the missile launched by India and will it lead to regional arms race?



India says it has successfully conducted its first test flight of a homegrown long-range ballistic missile capable of delivering multiple warheads to different targets, a significant development for the country's weapons programme.

Prime minister Narendra Modi took to X - formerly Twitter - to congratulate the scientists behind the Agni-5 missile, which derives its name from the Sanskrit language word for "fire" and is equipped with Multiple Independently Targetable Re-entry Vehicles (Mirv) technology. puts India among a relatively small club of countries including the US, Russia, China, France and the UK that are known to have Mirv-equipped missiles.

The missile's range of over 5000km and its general utility as a potential "first use" weapon in instigating a conflict have led experts to express concerns that the test will "trigger an arms race in the region and lead to increased instability over time", one analyst told The Independent.

SpaceX hoping to launch Starship farther in third test flight

SpaceX's Starship, set for its third uncrewed test launch, aims to surpass previous milestones despite the risk of another explosion. With new objectives like opening the payload door and reigniting an engine in space, the flight targets a splashdown in the Indian Ocean rather than a crash landing near Hawaii. Despite remaining far from full operational capability, Elon Musk envisions Starship as pivotal for lunar missions and Mars exploration, potentially replacing the Falcon 9 in commercial launches. SpaceX's risk-tolerant engineering culture, coupled with NASA's stake in its success for the Artemis program, underscores the urgency to advance Starship's development amidst competition with China in space exploration.

SpaceX's iterative testing approach, characterized by pushing spacecraft to failure to refine improvements, reflects a strategy aimed at rapid progress. While acknowledging the likelihood of setbacks, both Musk and NASA are committed to the long-term vision of Starship as a key player in space exploration.
