### Skyroot Aerospace successfully test-fires stage-2 of Vikram-1 rocket

The recent surge in the stock market saw the BSE Sensex gaining over 600 points, reaching 73,600, while the Nifty50 climbed above the 22,300 mark. This rally was fueled by various factors, including positive global cues, strong economic fundamentals, and increased investor confidence. Energy stocks benefited from a decline in crude oil prices, while IT stocks rebounded, contributing to the overall market upswing. TThe Mukesh Ambani company will invest Rs 50 crore for a 26% stake in a 600MW unit of Mahan Energen's thermal power plant. The latter is a wholly owned subsidiary of Gautam Adani-led Adani Power. Mahan Energen has agreed to allot 50 million equity shares of Rs 10 face value each to RIL at par, Reliance said in a regulatory filing. "The proposed investment by the company is in compliance with the provisions of the Electricity Rules, 2005," it said. RIL did not disclose any specific purpose for signing the power purchase agreement.

One unit of 600 MW capacity of Mahan thermal power plant, out of its aggregate operating and upcoming capacity of 2,800 MW, will be designated as the captive unit for this purpose," Adani Power said in a regulatory filing announcing the agreement with RIL.

### Climate activist Sonam Wangchuk ends fast after 21 days

In the last three years since Ladakh and J&K became separate Union Territories, some Ladakhis have become restive about broken promises. Educationist and climate activist Sonam Wangchuk completed his 21-day hunger strike on Tuesday, sleeping in the open despite temperatures. Why are Ladakhis on the streets? J&K and Ladakh were declared two separate UTs following the abrogation of Article 370 in August 2019. Soon after the euphoria of having an identity separate from J&K had died, Ladakhi people realised that creation of a UT left them without a legislature, depriving them of autonomy in governance. There are also concerns of adequate representation in govt jobs and land rights. What is the status now?

In Dec 2023, the Centre set up a highpowered committee to allay concerns and two meetings were held but not much headway has been made since. There has been reluctance on the part of govt to give in to demands for autonomy and statehood, keeping in view the strategic importance of the region.

India is a sovereign, socialist, secular, democratic republic. Democracy runs like a golden thread in the social, economic and political fabric woven by the Constitution given by 'We, the People of India' unto ourselves. The concept of democracy as visualised by the Constitution pre-supposes the representation of the people in Parliament and State legislatures by the method of election. The Supreme Court has held that democracy is one of the inalienable basic features of the Constitution of India and forms part of its basic structure. The Constitution of India adopted a Parliamentary form of government. Parliament consists of the President of India and the two Houses - Rajya Sabha and Lok Sabha, India, being a Union of states, has separate state legislatures for each state. State legislatures consist of the Governor and two Houses - Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly - in seven states, namely, Andhra Pradesh, Telangana, Bihar, Jammu & Kashmir, Karnataka, Maharashtra and Uttar Pradesh, and of the Governor and the state Legislative Assembly in the remaining 22 states. Apart from the above, two out of the seven Union Territories, namely, National Capital Territory of Delhi and Puducherry, also have their Legislative Assemblies.
